

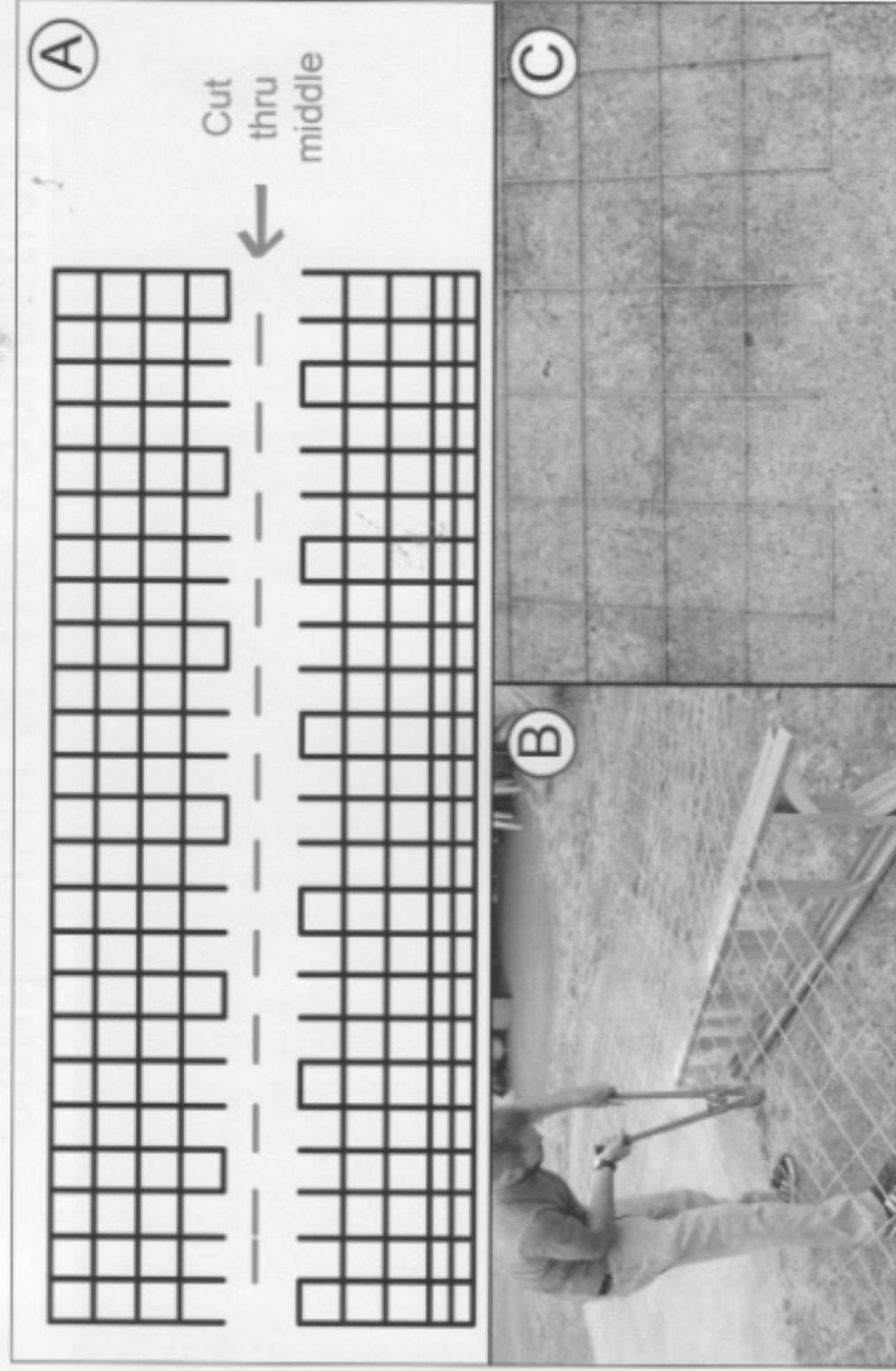


Figure 12. Images showing the process of cutting a cattle panel in half lengthwise

Cattle Panel—Prep Work (fig. 12):

Three-and-a-half 50"X16' cattle panels make up the roof structure. **Figure 12** shows how to cut the panel in half, because the full panels don't need any prep work. The red dashes (fig. 12A) are segments of the cattle panel that are cut

out with bolt cutters (fig. 12B). Notice the edge of the panel after it is cut in **Figure 12C**. Some of the grid squares have an edge missing and some don't. Take your time with this step. You get a gold star if you get this right the first time!
